

My project is a field of one foot wooden cubes, as a three dimensional representations of a four dimensional analog of a cube. My plan is for one hundred of these cubes for everyone to play with. There to be stacked, rolled, moved, and played with. My hope is that peoples interaction with the pieces will give the illusion that it is shifting on its own. Every time you notice the field of cubes off in the distance it has changed and morphed into something new. The cubes will not be painted, so that people can draw on them or write on them as they see fit. Come sunday night, I will get as many people as i can to help me gather the cubes and stack them in the fir pit near center camp, and set them ablaze.

A proof of concept has been built, and an understanding of the production of the cubes has been reached. It takes approx. 10 mins. to cut the lumbar for one cube. assembly time is approx. 20 min per cube for two people. While community support would be appreciated it will not be necessary to complete the project. The production of the cubes will be done durning the months of july and august hopefully in a few work week days. Transportation of the cubes to the site will be done with my brothers truck.

If full funding is not reached, I will make as many cubes as possible.
